Goal of the Project

The goal of this project will be to develop a community engagement strategy with a lens toward youth development and well-being of scholars within the five NAZ.

Project Objectives

- Investigate root causes of school safety issues and the impact on scholars.
- Conduct interviews with school leaders, scholars and NAZ staff.
- Coordinate Student led Community forums with stakeholders.
- Create a youth leadership strategy in partnership with NAZ leadership.

Responsibilities

- Work with NAZ leadership and staff to develop a community engagement strategy which promotes messaging and activities that foster improved school climate and supports the emotional health of scholars.
- Partner closely with VP of Education and Director of Education Partnerships to make connections and understand relationships with NAZ Anchor schools for effective collaboration.
- Research current school climate of Northside schools to gather data in formulating a comprehensive community engagement strategy around Youth leadership.
- Interview parents, scholars, school staff and NAZ staff to ascertain areas of opportunity for youth engagement.
- Work in partnership with the NAZ Community Wellness team to create an aligned approach to implementation and integration of wellness activities and strategies in the schools.
- Track and document progress of strategy implementation, interviews and challenges for the purpose of reporting and storytelling.

Eligibility

- Must be 18 years old by start date.
- Must be a U.S. citizen, legal permanent resident, refugee, asylee, or DACA recipient.
- Must be able to commit to a year-long program from June 2023 June 2024, with a full-time work week (35 hours per week daytime hours, Monday-Friday).
- We welcome applicants from any location, but you must be willing to live and work in Minnesota during the 2023-24 term of service.

Fellows are not required to have had previous job experience. This is an entry level position designed to catalyze your career and leadership development. We do, though, seek the following traits in all Fellows:
