About Move for America

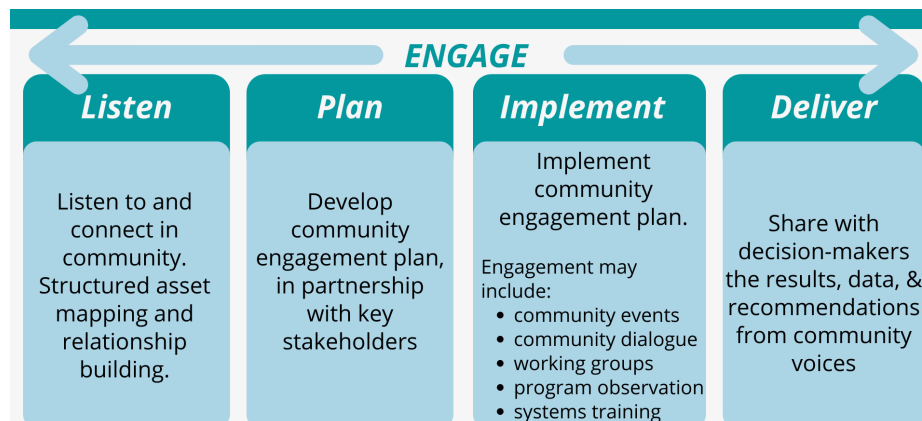

About the Fellowship

The Move for America Fellowship, in partnership with AmeriCorps VISTA, is a paid, 12-month immersive service learning experience grounded in community engagement and civic participation. As a Fellow, you will serve in a local nonprofit to convene diverse community perspectives to solve local challenges collaboratively and compassionately. All Fellows participate in our Inclusive Leadership training program, which includes over 80 hours of learning together with your cohort of Fellows, focused on intercultural communication, navigating conflict, and engaging communities. This Fellowship Program is the ideal opportunity to expand your horizons and launch a life of impact by bridging cultural and ideological differences.

Responsibilities

During their year of service, Fellows serve full-time in a local nonprofit organization on defined community-engagement activities. *Each site is unique.* The scope of each project and activity will vary based on the host site, based on the following overall annual plan:



The Move for America Fellowship is meant to be a transformative experience that builds Fellows' cross-cultural knowledge, Inclusive Leadership mindset and community engagement skills. It is a Fellow's responsibility to fully participate in activities planned for Fellows, and in the life of the community.

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Values

Move for America holds our staff, advisors, Fellows, and partners to the values of Respect, Growth, Openness, Community, and Accountability.

- **Respect** - We respect ourselves and others. We have confidence in our own ideas while seeking to understand and value alternative perspectives.

Fellows are not required to have had previous job experience. This is an entry level position designed to catalyze your career and leadership development. We do, though, seek the following traits in all Fellows:

- Curiosity - genuine interest to learn with and from others
- Growth - commitment to continuous learning about self and others
- Teamwork - capable of using collaboration and teamwork to achieve goals
- Community - desire to work in and with a community and in team environments
- Accountability - take responsibility for actions and their impact on others
- Leadership - take initiative and demonstrate leadership experience
